### LDA ESF Programme 2007-10 Youth Round

LDA ESF Programme 2007-10 Youth Round has now been launched by the LDA. This is the third prospectus launched by the LDA since the ESF 2007-13 programme began.

The ESF Youth Prospectus sets out project specifications to provide additional and complementary activity for young people under Priority 1.2 of the ESF Regional Framework and aims to increase the potential rate and quality of economic participation of London's young people.

Supporting young people to succeed in education and preparing them for the world of work is one of the keys to the economic success of the capital.

The mayor has identified this as a priority through the [Time for Action](#) plan and the LDA has identified the need for greater investment in youth opportunities in London to maximise young people's potential and to achieve optimum productivity, social inclusion and good health.

There are six project specifications for activity focused on young people under Priority 1,2 of the ESF Regional Framework.
